AREA FUNDRAISING ORGANIZER (VB02)

TASKS – VARY MONTH TO MONTH ACCORDING TO PRIORITIES

- Attend initial two-hour briefing session online
- Attend a one-hour quarterly review meeting online
- Investigate event venues
- Meet with potential sponsors and fundraisers (businesses and individual)
- Review funding applicants (startup businesses and schools)
- Arrange an Area Brit Club quarterly Member Social
- Agree Quarterly action plan with the General Manager

PREFERRED EXPERIENCE

- Involvement in Britevents Northwest for at least one year (host, VIP Club, event attendee)
- Commitment to the two fundraising projects managed by Britevents Northwest
- Experience of organizing events in other contexts
- Knowledge of local area (British venues, British groups, British social media, British businesses)

ORGANIZER RESTRICTIONS

- Must be a citizen or permanent resident of the USA
- Must be aged 18 or over
- Must reside or work in one of these States: Idaho, Oregon, Washington

BENEFITS

- Free VIP Membership of your area Brit Club
- \$50 monthly retainer payment (see note)
- Vouchers to spend at the Club online shop
- Access to BENW office resources e.g. briteeventsnw.com email address
- \$15 VIP Membership for a family member in your household aged 18 or over
- Expenses as approved by the General Manager
- May be combined with one other role at BENW (except Trustee position)

NOTE: The \$50 payment is taxable as 1099-NEC income. However, a 1099 tax form is only raised and notified to the IRS if total taxable income from BENW is \$600 or more. You also have the option for us to make full or part payment of the \$50 to a US based nonprofit of your choice. In this instance, that nonprofit does not have to have a British theme.
